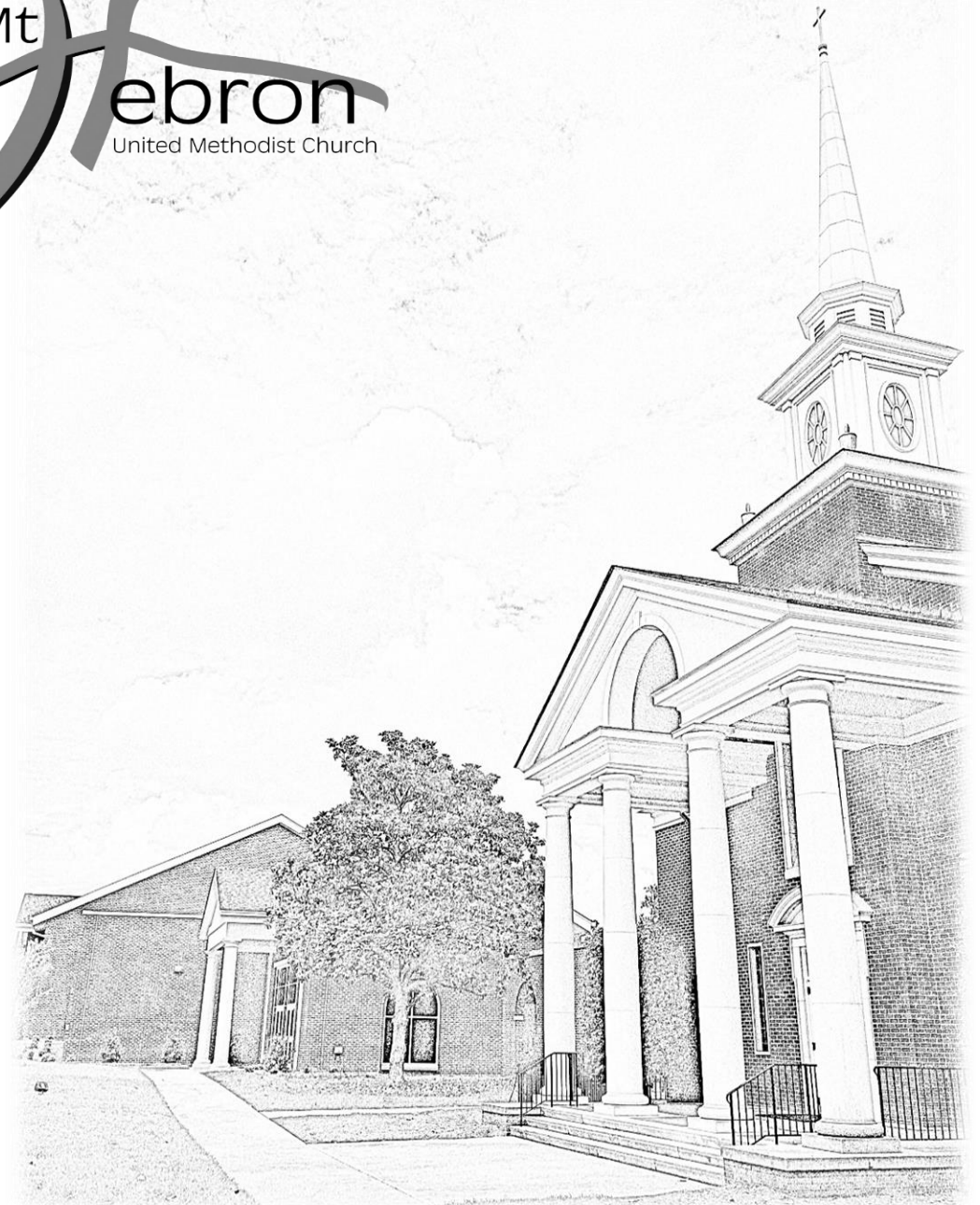
Information Session, June 11, at 4pm:

I am writing to you on behalf of the Advisory Committee on Discernment to let you know that we will have our second congregation-wide information session on June 11 at 4pm in the Family Life Center. This committee was created last December when the SC Conference released a discernment process for churches in light of the ongoing discussions of schism in the United Methodist Church. At the December meeting, Mt. Hebron's Church Council voted not to undergo this official discernment process at that time. Church Council instead decided to form the Advisory Committee on Discernment to gather information about what was going on in the denomination and present it to the congregation. Subsequently, on May 22 Church Council did vote to allow the Church to pursue possible separation from the denomination of which the first step is a minimum 30-day discernment process. Church Council has asked our Committee to provide one more informational meeting in case anyone was not able to attend the first meeting in April. Although confusing, this Advisory Committee on Discernment is separate from the vote on May 22 and this committee will end immediately after this meeting. A resource document was emailed out to all members with an email address known to the Church office. If you did not receive the document and would like one, please contact the Church office to discuss how to get a copy. If you have any questions, please reach out either to Rev. Cynthia, Rev. Scripture Reading Acts 2:1-21, NRSV

2When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. 2And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. 3Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. 4All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. 5Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. 6And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. 7Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans?" 8And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? 9Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, 10Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, 11Cretans and Arabs—in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power." 12All were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" 13But others sneered and said, "They are filled with new wine." 14But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them, "Men of Judea and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say. 15Indeed, these are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only nine o'clock in the morning. 16No, this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: 17In the last days it will be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams. 18Even upon my slaves, both men and women, in those days I will pour out my Spirit; and they shall prophesy. 19And I will show portents in the heaven above and signs on the earth below, blood, and fire, and smoky mist. 20The sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood, before the coming of the Lord's great and glorious day. 21Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.'
