## Message from Pastor Ann

"Wateryougivinupferlent?" This was a question I heard every year as a child. It ranks up there with "Verge and Mary" and "but deliver us some email" with religious phrases that run together in the ears of children. And maybe even into adulthood. I recognized the code-phrase and how to answer it: soft drinks, or candy, or ice cream. Always sweets. Which, ironically, were rarely found in the deRosset household, except for Daddy's stash of Pepsi.



We attended church irregularly, but the Episcopal and Methodist roots were there with my parents, so they annually posed the question. I know now that what we practice during Lent is a deep rooting out and letting go of those things that obstruct our relationship with God. That's a very simple way of defining penitence, because the things that hinder our walk with Jesus are sin, even things society calls "good." Cravings, compulsions, our schedule, anything that robs us of our time with God and diverts us from those spiritual practices—or Means of Grace—Christ has given to draw us closer to God.

It's not always about giving up something. Sometimes we clear our path to God by adding spiritual practices and time with God: get up earlier for daily Bible reading and prayer; join a Bible study; attend Lenten services; join a Sunday School class; keep a gratitude list; serve on an outreach ministry; smile at strangers; attend Ash Wednesday and all Holy Week services. These are just a few. Pray for discernment and feel God's Spirit leading you to your Lenten commitment. Maybe the best thing for you is to give up sweets.


