We are again blessed with the opportunity to be a part of the work Henderson Settlement is doing in their rural Kentucky community. On April 23rd Ward Smith will be going up to deliver your gifts of funds and supplies needed for the various programs highlighted below and to serve on the campus and in the community. Needs include:

Senior Programs are requesting funds to enable them to provide meals and activities for seniors at the on-campus community center. **Senior Community Services**, whose mission includes delivering meals and visiting with seniors in outlying areas, are requesting monetary donations to help with the cost of travel involved in getting to these remote areas.

The **Food Pantry** requests monetary gifts to enable them to purchase food items in bulk for the food boxes they give out. They again have access to these food items and can purchase them locally. If you would like to donate specific items, they are requesting peanut butter, canned vegetables and pasta.

The **Baby Pantry**, part of the MIHOW program for young mothers and babies, needs funds as well as diapers (sizes 4, 5, & 6), baby formula, layette items, blankets, wipes and clothes for infants through 5 year olds.

School Supplies needed for getting ready to go back to school in the fall are: Pencil boxes, folders with metal prongs, notebook paper, highlighters, Crayola crayons, glue and pencils.
