Mt. Hebron United Methodist Church History Fact

DID YOU KNOW? The membership continued to grow & in 1837, the first church (by this time we were called "Hebron") at the present site was built on 4 acres donated by John & Elizabeth Roof. Half of it was set aside for a cemetery.

Sunday School was organized some time before 1850. The Temperance Hall, where "The Sons of Temperance" held meetings, was erected in the early 1860s. The Women's Missionary Society was organized in 1885. In 1887, R.N.

"Uncle Robbie" Senn gave another 1/2 acre for the cemetery.
