# **Henderson Settlement 2026 Spring Needs**

**Summer Recreation Day Camp**, which provides two meals and activities for area children for eight weeks during the summer, needs funds to purchase the food and supplies that are necessary to keep this program going.

**Senior Meals Programs** is also requesting funds to enable them to provide meals and activities for seniors at the on-campus community center. School Supplies that will be needed to get students ready to go back to school in August are: Pencil boxes, folders with metal prongs, notebook paper, spiral notebooks, highlighters, Crayola crayons, glue, pencils, pens.

**The Baby Pantry (MIHOW)**, for young mothers and babies, needs funds in addition to diapers (sizes 4,5, & 6), baby formula, layette items, blankets, wipes and clothes for infants to 5 year olds.

**The Food Pantry**, which provides food bags for area residents weekly, requests monetary gifts to enable them to purchase food items in bulk from local sources. If you would like to donate specific items, they are requesting peanut butter, canned vegetables, spaghetti sauce and pasta.

**Senior Community Services**, whose mission includes delivering meals and visiting with seniors in outlying areas, are requesting monetary donations to help with the cost of travel involved in getting to these remote areas.

Please make checks out to Henderson Settlement with the name of the program you would like to support, one of those shown above in bold, on the memo line. Put cash donations in an envelope labeled with the name of the area you want to support.

Donations of food or other requested items may be placed in the boxes labeled Henderson Settlement located at the various entrances to the church. Please turn any monetary donations in to the church office or bring them to the drop off.

A drive-by drop off is planned. Look out for dates and times in your bulletin or Mt. Hebron's e-news. Please be in prayer for the people of Henderson Settlement, the work they are doing, for our role in supporting this mission, and for my travels as I share your gifts, prayers and love.
