Thank You Again, and We Will Always Love You, Mt. Hebron!



We meet each Tuesday morning 9:30-11:30 in Room 401 and the second Saturday of each month, 9;30-11:30, Room 401

If you are unable to attend in person but would like to be a part of "Wrapped in Prayer" by creating prayer shawls and quilts at home, that would be wonderful! We have several members that create only from home and they are a vital part of this meaningful ministry.

Our prayer is that every person wrapped in a prayer shawl or quilt will be comforted by God's healing Presence and be reminded of His Love and Grace. Also, we pray that everyone holding a prayer pocket will be reminded of how much God loves and cares for them. He promises to never leave us or forsake us.

Three ways all of Mt Hebron can be involved:

*Notify the church office or any member of "Wrapped in Prayer" when you know of someone going through a difficult situation (such as illness or grief) and feel they would be blessed by being "Wrapped in Prayer" and receiving a prayer shawl or quilt.

*Pray for those that will be receiving the prayer shawls and quilts that are placed on the altar each month, usually the second Sunday.

*Keep an extra prayer pocket on hand to give to someone that needs to know, or to be reminded of, how much God loves them. Baskets of prayer pockets are always in the narthex of the sanctuary and in the Family Life Center.
